Regulations summary

Eligible applicants : NGO, association, territorial authority, municipality, small and medium-sized enterprise, scientific institution.

Eligible countries: every country in the Mediterranean region with priority to the following countries: Albania, Algeria, Egypt, Lebanon, Morocco, Montenegro, the Palestinian Territories, Tunisia, Turkey, Cyprus, Croatia, Malta and Greece.

BeMed's contribution for each project: up to 10 000 € maximum.

BeMed's maximum contribution : shall not exceed 75 % of overall costs.

Duration of the project : between 12 and 18 months maximum.

Start of the project : from june 2023.

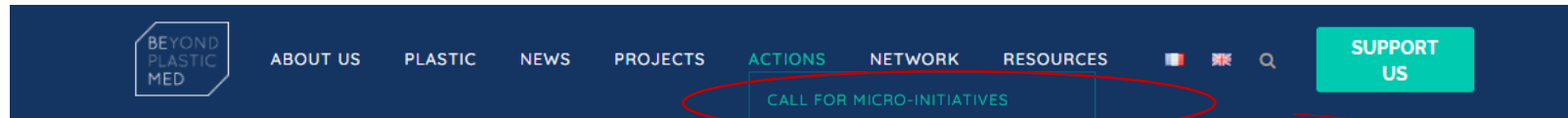


Eligible stakeholders: NGOs, territorial authorities, municipalities, private companies with fewer than 20 employees, scientific institutions.

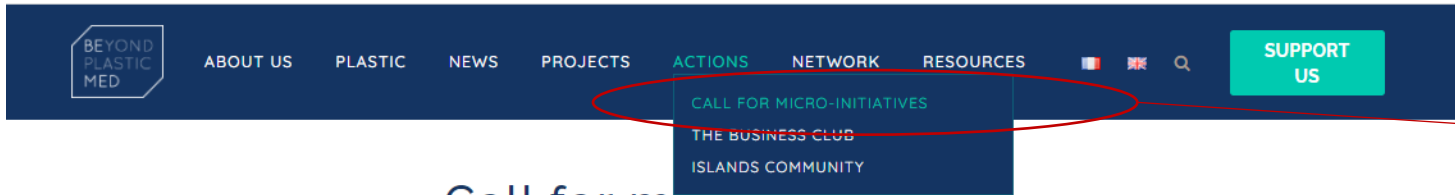

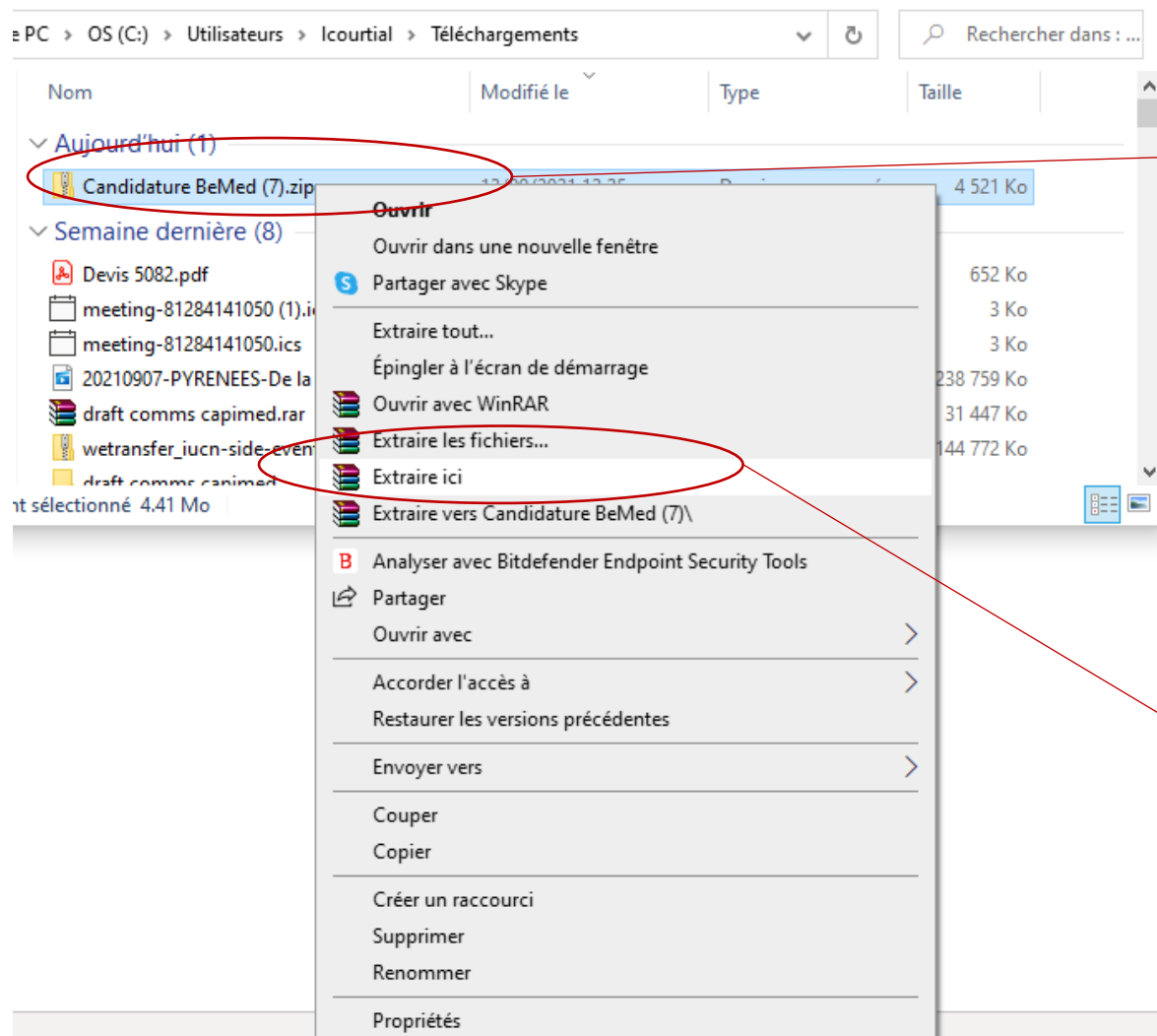

Address and format for submitting your Application File

Opening of the submission of applications: 30th of September 2021.
Any questions concerning the application file to be sent to the secretariat before 23rd of December 2021.
Closing: 2nd of January 2022 – 8PM (Paris time, GMT+2).
Decision : not to expect before the 21th of March 2022.

Please send your Application file on to the following address: ami@beyondplasticmed.org

List of documents to send with your application:

- Publication in the Official Gazette or KBIS extract or any other document proving the existence of the organization: its identity, address, activity and the identity of its managers.
- Articles of association/organisation.
- An English or French translation of the following information: company's object, the address of the head of office, the organisation chart and the official registration number.
- Bank details (official document from the bank and in addition to the banking information requested in section 6)
- Any document you wish to submit to support your initiative and your application
- Proof of support commitments made by acquired partners (as referred in section 5.7)

It must be in Word format (not a PDF file) and consist of one single file.

The " Application BeMed Provisional Budget.xls" chart must be pasted into the document and sent together at the same time with this application in Excel "xls" format.

We would like to draw your attention to the fact that all sections must be completed in order for your application to be processed.

- Bank account statement.
- An exhaustive list of board members and their identification paper

- Questions concerning the application file to be sent before 20th of December 2022.
- Documents to be sent by e-mail before Tuesday 3rd of January 2023 at 8 pm.
- The secretariat will acknowledge receipt of the file.
- Answer during March 2023.
