Title of the solution: One recycle carton box with all amenities

Solution tested by: *Name of the hotel*

Single-use plastic(s) targeted: *Describe the use*

All Guest room aménités are placed in a single recyclable carton box containing the necessary products. Items that require individual packaging for hygiene purposes are wrapped in PLA (a biodegradable material) instead of conventional plastic

Technical and economic information: *Suppliers, prices...*

Compared to conventional plastic packaging, the cost is slightly higher. However, the solution provides a more attractive and premium presentation of the amenities while promoting the hotel's environmental commitment and sustainability goals.

Social and environmental aspects: *Acceptability to customers and staff, recyclability...*

The amenities themselves have not changed ; only their packaging has been replaced to eliminate single-use plastic. Both guests and staff have provided positive feedback, finding the solution more practical, organized, and visually appealing. In addition, the use of recyclable and biodegradable materials helps reduce plastic waste and its environmental impact.

Your advice: *For hotel managers*

Choose unified, recyclable packaging for Guest amenities to reduce the use of single-use plastics without compromising quality or hygiene. This solution provides better organization, creates a positive impression on guests, and contributes to the hotel's sustainability goals.
